

here is arguably no one alive today who is more universally beloved and respected than Tenzin Gyatso, the 14th Dalai Lama. His smiling face is truly one of the most recognizable in the world — and when we read about his life story (especially young adulthood), his grace and compassion are all the more impressive.

As the Dalai Lama celebrates his 82nd birthday this month, we take a closer look at his Western astrological profile and what it says about his inspiration life journey. How much do we really know about this iconic, historical figure who walks among us?

Tenzin Gyatso was born on the 6th of July, 1935 in the tiny village of Takster, Tibet. That makes him a Cancer in the Western zodiac and a Sheep in the ancient Chinese system. He was only two years old, just learning to walk and talk, when senior Tibetan monks — led by vivid prophecies and visions — arrived at the simple home where his family lived. The traditional process for identifying a reincarnated Tibetan Lama is meticulous, including a number of tests where the child is presented two objects — one that belonged to the recently deceased Lama, and one that did not. Tenzin passed the tests with surprising swiftness, choosing all of the correct objects and giving strong indications that he was their owner.

Much of next twelve years of Tenzin's life would be spent in the company of accomplished monks who tutored the young boy in a wide range of subjects, including the Tibetan language (which is not his first language) and Buddhist teachings, from the basic precepts to deeper, more esoteric secrets. Since this young boy would become the spiritual and even political figurehead of the Tibetan people, education was relentless.

When these early years are considered, two things jump out of the Dalai Lama's astrological chart: Both his sun and moon are in first house Cancer. This is one of the most psychic and intuitive signs of the zodiac, and many

Cancerians have a special interest in hidden occult teachings. Cancer is also a sign that prefers to live in a cautious, protected setting. It makes sense that the young Tenzin would absorb his lessons like a sponge, and would not mind the long hours spent in meditation and study. By the tender age of 15, he was officially installed as the 14th Dalai Lama.

What happened next is a famous and closely-scrutinized story. Caught up in geopolitical turmoil, the Dalai Lama was forced to flee Tibet and make his way on foot through treacherous Himalayan passes in order to reach India. Once there, he began the business of setting up a Tibetan government in exile. Mars in Libra is a clear indicator that fairness and justice would be pillars of his personality throughout these crucial years.

Fast forward to today. The Dalai Lama has publicly abandoned his efforts toward Tibetan independence, focusing his efforts on universal teachings of compassion. Instead of remaining rigid and inflexible in his defense of Buddhism and the Tibetan identity, he has emphasized cross-cultural understanding and the importance of scientific advancement. He regularly meets with many of the world's most influential people, displaying a humorous and playful nature in public teachings and interviews. Saturn retrograde in Pisces, near the Dalai Lama's midheaven, is the most obvious astrological evidence of this contemporary style. But as we can see from the moon in Virgo and Mars in Libra, that "contemporary flexibility" only extends so far. The daily routines of Holiness remain steeped in the disciplines of Tibet's highest ranking Buddhist monk, including a 3 am wake-up call, 5 daily hours of concentrated meditation, and travel schedule that is far more rigorous than any previous Dalai Lama.

Two things can definitely be said about this very special human being: That he is one of the most notable spiritual teachers alive, and that his message of compassion goes far beyond any one creed.

uman history is full of fascinating mystical rites, from all corners of the world and every chapter in history. But few practices are so widespread and persistent as smudging — that is, burning specific medicinal or fragrant plants or resins, and using the smoke as a way to cleanse the energetic and physical body.

Most of us have tried smudging at some point, or observed others doing it. When done with love and care, using quality materials, it's a satisfying sensory experience. But how does smudging really work? Is there any kind of metaphysical (or even scientific) explanation for this age-old practice?

Let's start with science. A 2007 study in the Journey of Ethnopharmacology made a detailed assessment of air quality before and after smudging, including various medicinal smudging mixtures in more than 50 different countries. The researchers found that smudging eradicated around 94% of bacteria in the air. Astonishingly, these purifying effects could still be observed after an entire month. So when you consider the fact that air in highly populated areas contains high levels of bacteria, smudging is worth it — even from a purely scientific standpoint.

But is this all there is to smudging? Here is where we move into the psychic, intuitive and energetic ways of understanding the world. Human beings know intuitively — and have for

many centuries — that physical spaces and living beings have an energetic aspect that is not visible in 'ordinary' terms. Psychic vibrations, thoughts, intentions, past events, emotional energies, and even dreams can affect physical spaces and bodies. In the case of a physical being (whether human or animal), dark or unwanted energies may develop in the energetic body or aura. In the case of physical spaces, these energies can develop and affect anyone who enters the space, latching in to their spiritual or energetic body.

Like much of the 'intuitive' or psychic knowledge that has come down to us through the ages, none of this can be proven with the instruments of science. But there is a reason why psychics, healers, shamans, priests, and spiritual practitioners of all stripes have consistently used medicinal smoke to purify. Plus, the fact that science verifies a physical benefit to smudging is no small detail!

People have different ideas or "sensations" when it comes to psychic or spiritual phenomena. One person may have the gift of seeing auras or energetic bodies in a way that almost mimics "normal" vision. Another may be "clairsentient" — meaning they can feel things on a psychic level. When you go about your smudging routine, it's important to remember that your sense of cleansing could take any or all of these forms, depending on how you see the world psychically.

So what's a good smudging routine, and what are the main tools used for smudging? First of all, it's good to remember that smudging can be used to cleanse and heal people, animals, and physical spaces. Sometimes, you'll want to do all of three at once. If you're walking around the house with a sage wand, for instance, you'll probably want to smudge your own body (in addition to loved ones and pets) in the process. The medicinal smoke is like a psychic shower. Many people have specific rituals and smudging bowls, and make use of crystals or other talismans to amplify the power of smudging (crystals themselves can be purified with medicinal smoke, and most crystal healers agree that this is necessary).

In terms of which herbs and plants to use, everybody has different spiritual connections with different plants. Here is a short list to consider, but there are many more. Happy smudging!

n ancient times, it was believed that the Ruby surpassed all other precious stones in virtue, and its value exceeded even that of the Diamond. In some cultures it was reputed to bring its owner peace and tranquillity. People believed it would drive away frightful dreams, restrain lust, and help resolve disputes. Burmese Legend declares that if you insert a Ruby into the flesh it would make you completely invulnerable.

The ancient Hindus called the July birthstone "Rajinapura" or King of Gems, and believed the stone to radiate a warmth and

luminosity from the internal flame. This was linked to love and passion that emanates from the heart, making this precious stone the perfect for ardent lovers.

Ruby's metaphysical properties are no less astounding in modern times. As a healing tool the vibrant Ruby actively stimulates the Base Chakra, increasing vitality and chi; the life-force energy that runs throughout the physical and spiritual body. As a powerful heart stone, Ruby is a force to be reckoned with. It can be used to open and activate the Heart Chakra. It can protect against the loss of heart energy, and dissolvesemotional congestion. Ruby can even initiate sensual pleasure of life!
